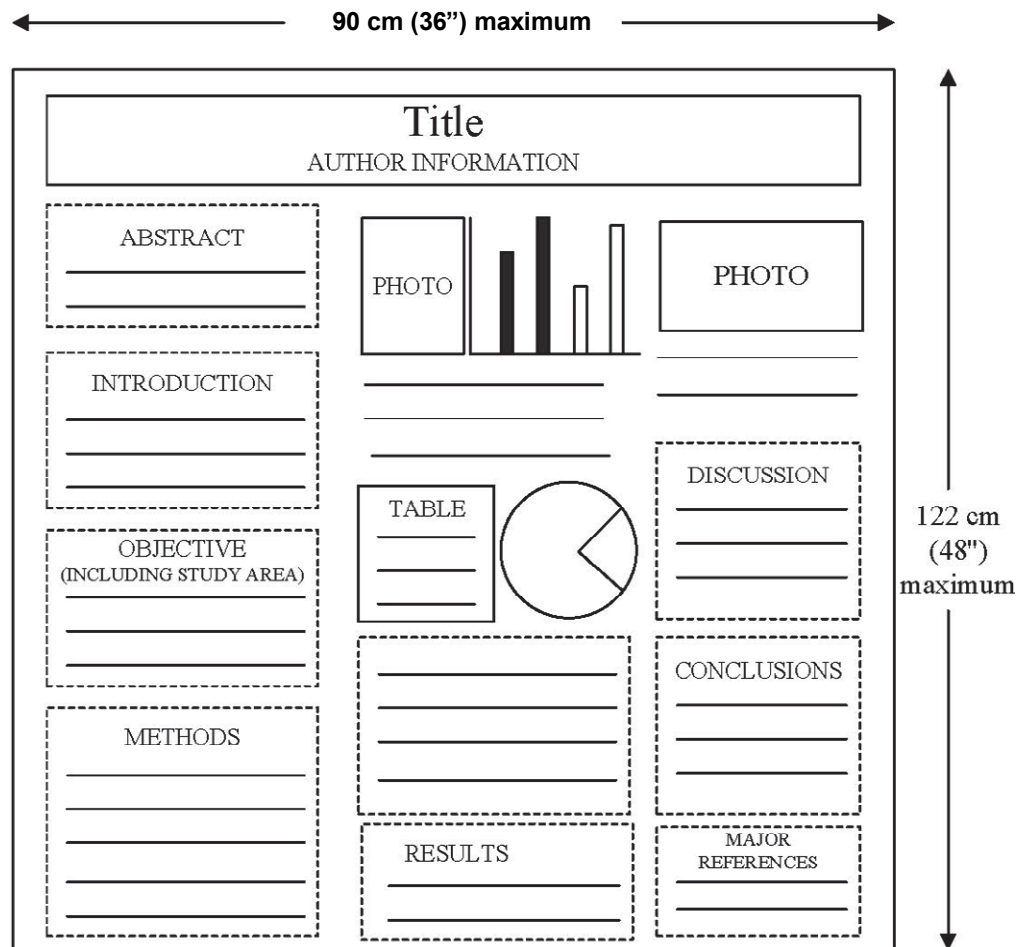
Content

Posters may highlight on going work or research by young or Dragon 3 scientists.

Dimensions of Poster Presentations

- Poster width should not exceed 90 cm (36").
- Poster height should not exceed 122 cm (48").

See following sample.



Design and Format

- Use graphs, charts and illustrations as much as possible. Minimize use of text and tables.
- Use large bold lettering for readability (minimum font size 14pt non-serif e.g. Arial).
- Graphic poster presentations should be readable from 2.4m (8) away.
- The use of colour graphics will enhance poster readability and attractiveness.

Content

- Title: **BOLD AND UPPER CASE**, followed by author's name and affiliation; include email addresses and web addresses if appropriate.
- Abstract: - do not to exceed 500 words
- Introduction
- Objective (including study area if have)
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Major references (maximum of 5 citations)
- Use borders or white space to separate sections.

Mounting

Posters should be mounted during the 1st and 2nd days of the Symposium (03 & 04 June 2013) or following on arrival. Materials for mounting posters will be provided at the poster session venue.

Poster Presentation Session

Young & Dragon scientists will be expected to present their posters to the Dragon 3 cooperation scientific community at a dedicated session in the evening of Tuesday 04 June 2013. Dragon scientists will be present to read the posters and ask questions.

Information on specific poster setup and presentation times will be emailed to authors at a later date. Poster presenters may want to have A4 copies of their posters and their business cards available for distribution.

Please also provide your poster in electronic format .pdf version by email to the dragon account by no later than 7 June 2013 (dragon@esa.int) . Following, your poster will be linked to the on-line Symposium programme for reference. Please follow the convention for file naming:
