Participants of this tour will visit the ancient capital of Macedonia, Aegae, nowadays known as Vergina, where they will have the chance to see the monumental palace, lavishly decorated with mosaics and painted stuccoes, and the burial ground with more than 300 tumuli, some of which date from the 11th century B.C. More importantly, Vergina hosts the Royal Tomb of King Philip II of Macedonia, father of Alexander the Great that was discovered by archaeologist Manolis Andronikos in 1977.

The excursion includes wine tasting and lunch at a local winery. Northern Greece is one of the most important wine producing areas of the country with high quality production and talented winemakers.
